

Past, Present, and Future Tense

Past Tense

Add "-ed" at the end of the word

Paint → I painted.

Change the word completely

Run → I ran.

Used for:

Yesterday, A long time ago,

Last week, Last month,

Last year, five years ago

Present Tense

Add "to be" + add "-ing"
at the end of the verb

Paint → I am painting.

You are painting.

He is painting.

Used for:

Today,
Right now

Future Tense

Add "will" + the verb

Paint → I will paint.

You will paint.

He will paint.

Used for:

Tomorrow, The following week,

Next week, Next time,

Next month, In five years
